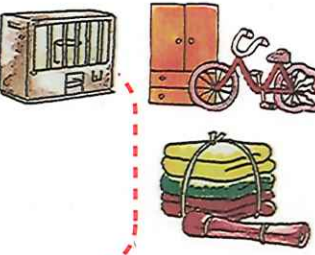


Sorting Garbage by Type

	How to Separate	How to Dispose (Up to three bags per disposal)
① BURNABLE GARBAGE Twice a Week	Wet Waste kitchen scraps, clam shells, cigarette butts, etc. Wood Waste grass cuttings, wood scraps, bamboo, etc. Leather Items ... shoes, bags, etc. Rubber Items ... rubber boots, etc. Fabric Waste cushions, futons and other items with cotton stuffing, rags, torn cloth, and curtains Paper Waste dirty paper, disposable diapers, wax paper, thermal paper, and carbon paper	◆ Use official garbage bags for disposal. (45ℓ, 30ℓ, 20ℓ, or 10ℓ) ○ Tie small branches and wood boards in bundles less than 50 cm long and 30 cm in diameter (Up to three bundles per disposal). ○ Dispose twigs, leaves, and other loose matter in official garbage bags.
② PAPER & CLOTH Twice a Month	Newspapers newspapers and ad inserts Magazines magazines, documents, wrapping paper, cardboard, apparel boxes, etc. Paper Cartons.. drink cartons over 500 ml (dispose any carton with silver-paper lining as "Mixed Paper") Mixed Paper..... memo paper, receipts, letters, snack boxes, small cartons, etc. Cloth Waste shirts, sheets, blankets, towels, etc.  Items with this recycle symbol Questions about Paper & Cloth Waste: Koshi Recycle Jigyo Kumiai K.K. Futami ☎23-3125 	◆ Separate paper items by type and tie up. ◆ Put "Mixed Paper" items in a paper bag secured with string, staples, tape, or other material, marked "SONOTAKAMI". ◆ Dispose "Cloth Waste" in transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45ℓ. ◆ Dispose cloth-covered paper as ① BURNABLE GARBAGE. ○ Rinse "Paper Cartons" and open flat before disposal. ※ Do not dispose "Cloth Waste" on rainy days. ※ Paper items will be picked up on rainy days as long as the weather is not too severe.
③ PET BOTTLES Twice a Month	Beverage Bottles Soy Sauce Bottles Alcohol & Mirin Bottles  Items with this recycle symbol 	◆ Use transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45ℓ. ○ Rinse well and let dry before disposal. ※ Remove PET bottle caps and dispose as ④ TRAYS and PLASTIC CONTAINERS. Metal caps must be disposed as ⑦ NONBURNABLE GARBAGE.
④ TRAYS & PLASTIC CONTAINERS Once a Week	Packaging Trayscolored, white, and transparent Bags polyurethane and plastic Plastic Containers.....detergent bottles, PET bottle caps, egg cartons, cooking oil and sauce containers, polystyrene boxes, etc.  Items with this recycle symbol	◆ Use transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45ℓ. ○ Wash well and let dry before disposal. ○ Paper lids for instant noodle cups must be disposed separately as ② PAPER & CLOTH "Mixed Paper". ○ Toothpaste tubes and other hard-to-clean containers must be disposed as ① BURNABLE GARBAGE. ○ Plastic waste other than containers must be disposed as ⑦ NONBURNABLE GARBAGE.
⑤ CANS Twice a Month	Beverage Cans Food Cans 	◆ Use transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45ℓ. ○ Food cans should be rinsed well or wiped clean before disposal. ○ 18ℓ square cans and other large cans must be disposed as ⑦ NONBURNABLE GARBAGE.
⑥ GLASS BOTTLES & JARS Twice a Month	Bottles and jars for beverages or food, including broken ones 	◆ Use transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45ℓ. ○ Wash before disposal. ○ Bottle caps, stoppers and cosmetics bottles/jars must be disposed as ⑦ NONBURNABLE GARBAGE.
⑦ NONBURNABLE GARBAGE Once a Month	Metal Waste pots, kettles, frying pans, umbrellas, 18ℓ square cans, and other large cans for cookies, milk, tea, and other material Plastic Waste Other Than Containers toys, planters, CDs, DVDs, etc. Ceramics and Porcelain plates, bowls, plant pots, and vases Glass Waste mirrors, light bulbs, glow lamps, broken fluorescent tubes, cosmetic bottles/jars, and glass cups	◆ Use transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45ℓ. ○ Wrap sharp items like blades or shards in paper or cloth before disposal. ○ Portable cooking stoves and gas heaters must have their batteries and fuel canisters removed before disposal. ※ Do not dispose lighters or aerosol cans as ⑦ NONBURNABLE GARBAGE, because they are fire hazards for garbage trucks and for others.
⑧ FLUORESCENT TUBES AEROSOL CANS & FUEL CANISTERS DRY CELL BATTERIES & LIGHTERS VIDEO & CASSETTE TAPES COOKING OIL Once a Month	Each waste type should be disposed in a separate bag (cooking oil should be disposed in a PET bottle). - Unbroken Fluorescent Tubes - Aerosol Cans and Fuel Canisters - Cylindrical Dry Cell Batteries and Lighters - Videotapes and Cassette Tapes - Used Cooking Oil 	◆ Fluorescent Tubes, Aerosol Cans and Fuel Canisters, Dry Cell Batteries and Lighters, Video and Cassette Tapes must be disposed by type in separate transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45ℓ. ◆ Used Cooking Oil must be disposed in a PET bottle with "SHOKUYO ABURA" and "KAKI GENKIN" clearly written on it. ○ Empty aerosol cans and fuel canisters before disposal. ● Do not dispose button cells and NiCd batteries. Inquire at the place of purchase about correct battery disposal.
⑨ OVERSIZED GARBAGE	Waste that does not fit in a 45ℓ bag is Oversized Garbage. [Pickup Reservation] Recycle Center ☎32-1153 [Center Hours] M-F: 9:00-16:00 National Holidays: 9:00-11:00 (Closed on Saturday and Sunday) 	◆ Oversized Garbage pickup must be requested by phone. ○ Call the Center → Reserve a pickup date → Purchase an Oversized Garbage Sticker for each item (¥1,000 ea.) → Place the sticker on the item and set in front of the house on pickup date → Pickup completed ○ Stickers can be purchased at convenience stores, liquor stores, supermarkets and other outlets. ※ Some items may not be collected, such as items more than 4 meters long or over 100 kg.
